

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

If English is not your first language, you will need to provide documentation of your English language level. VIA University College requires that you have an English level of B2 or higher (According to Common European Frame of Reference).

As documentation, we accept the following internationally recognized language tests and minimum test score:

IELTS	An average band score of 6.5
TOEFL Internet-based	83
TOEFL Paper-based (valid until June 2019)	585
TOEFL Paper-delivered	Reading – high (22-30); Listening – high (22-30); Writing – Good (24-30)

Please be aware that your test scores are only valid for 2 years after the test date.

Applicants who are native speakers or have proof of secondary school education from the UK, Australia, the USA, Canada and New Zealand are exempt from the English language admission requirements.

Applicants from Iceland, Norway, Sweden and Finland do not need to be tested in English for the English speaking study programs. Their high school diploma will be converted to Danish grade levels and they will then be assessed and admitted according to the requirements for Danish applicants.
